

Pyrenees: Biarritz to Barcelona

This 25-day trip takes us down the west coast of France with the chance to visit Bordeaux and Biarritz before heading into the Basque region of Spain around San Sebastian. We then follow a path on the southern slopes of the Pyrenees via Pamplona, Huesca and finally onto the Catalan coast at Barcelona. Our journey north takes in the tiny, unspoilt principality of Andorra and a stunning section of the French Pyrenees around Foix, before our drive home through the centre of France.

ITINERARY:

NIGHT BEFORE: We stay on a campsite close to Dover where we provide a full briefing for the tour and advice on motorhoming on the continent in general. This is a complimentary night and you are welcome to join us at no additional cost.

DAYS 1 - 3: Over the first three days we make our way down through France with overnight stops in the Seine Maritime region as we head to the west coast near La Rochelle. From there we follow the coast down to Bordeaux.

DAYS 4 - 5: We spend two nights near Bordeaux allowing for a full day in the city famous for its wine, but also an elegant port town packed with art, architecture and restaurants.

DAYS 6 - 7: We continue to follow the west coast of France down the Bay of Biscay with a further two-night stop close to the attractive seaside resort of Biarritz.

DAYS 8 - 9: We are into the Pyrenees for the first time today, with the mountain range forming a natural border between France and Spain. We cross at the narrowest point around San Sebastian where we will spend a couple of nights in Basque country.

DAYS 10 - 11: We head to the capital of the Navarre region, Pamplona made famous for the 'running of the bulls'. This will not be on during our visit allowing us

time to walk the network of attractive narrow streets with history dating back to Roman times.

DAYS 12 - 13: We continue to head east skirting the southern slopes of the Pyrenees for the next two days. This is fairly uninhabited, rural terrain and we will be staying in the foothills in the area around Huesca.

DAYS 14 - 16: The tour changes pace as we head for the Catalan capital of Barcelona, which is also Spain's second largest city. Our schedule allows for two full days in the city, which is also close to the sea on the Costa Brava.

DAYS 17 - 18: Another change of pace today as head right into the heart of the Pyrenees to the tiny principality of Andorra, where we will spend two nights, allowing for a day in the 'capital', Andorra la Vella.

DAYS 19 - 20: Heading away from the Pyrenees we pass through the lush Ariege Valley in France where we will spend two nights around Foix.

DAYS 21 - 22: We continue our journey north through France with a night around Limoges with its medieval half-timbered houses and a night in the Loire region.

DAYS 23 - 25: We head towards Calais with further stops in the Loire and Seine Maritime regions before embarking on the ferry.

ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS/COSTS:

- There are toll charges on French and Spanish motorways.
- You need a low emission zone sticker for France.
